Draft Minutes of an Ordinary Meeting held on Thursday 15th May

1 Apologies: None

2 Minutes of meeting held on 28 March 2014: These were read, approved and signed by the Chairman.

3 Matters arising:

- Cllr Thomas whether the Minutes properly represented the discussion about the Planning Application. In reply, the Clerk apologised if that had happened, but he pointed out that the Minutes had been circulated in draft form and he had not received any suggested amendments or corrections.
- No reply has been received from Mr R Watkins to the letter sent to him regarding a possible Permissive Path across his land. It is hoped that a reply will be forthcoming soon.

4 Correspondence:

1. A letter was read stating that the Queens's Baton Relay would be passing through Llandrindod. Subsequently the Clerk received a poster describing the events which will take place on that day: copies of the poster have been placed on the noticeboards.

5 Llanfihangel Rhydithon Relief in Need Fund:

The Clerk reported that he had been asked by Canon Loat, who has now left the area, to register himself as the Correspondent for CCLA in respect of the COIF Investment account. When he did this he was told by CCLA that he should register two new signatories to this account since the existing signatories have left the area: the Chairman and Vice -Chair agreed to allow their names to go forward.

The Clerk reported that Canon Loat had not been able to find any documents relating to this Fund, that is, no Governing Document in which one would expect to find details concerning the distribution of assets if the Fund ceased to operate. Councillors suggested that it should be woundup and the proceeds, estimated to be about £1900, used to purchase a defibrillator and cabinet which would be of potential benefit to the whole community. A final decision is yet to be made.

6 Accounts for the year ending 31st March 2014:

The Accounts, which had been audited by Mr K Morris, were presented to the Council, approved and signed by the Chairman for submission to BDO, the external auditor.
