## **Minutes of an Ordinary Meeting held on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2015**

**2 Minutes of the meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2015:** These were read, approved and signed by the Chairman

**3 Matters arising:**

- The Clerk reported that HMRC has now approved the Llanfihangel Rhydithon Relief in Need Charity as a charity for tax purposes
- The Clerk has still not received any reply to his letter to Welsh Hearts

**4 Correspondence:**

- An email from Powys CC concerning work which has been done at the Craffryn, a listed building, had been sent to all councillors in advance of this meeting. The Clerk was instructed to write to the Planning Officer requesting that one or two councillors be present when the Officer meets the Craffryn householders.
- The Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013 requires Community Councils to have websites; to publish notices and papers electronically; and to publish a register of members' interests electronically. The Act requires that the political affiliation of members of the Council be published.
- The Clerk was instructed to write to the Planning Officer dealing with the Tynywern planning application to ask for a response to the Council's comments made about work which has already been done there.

**5 To receive reports from the Council's representatives on the Governing Body of the Primary School and the Management Committee of the DRA.**

- Cllr Bufton reported that the school has 30 pupils on roll and that the school is working well.
- There was no DRA report.

**6 Audited Accounts:** The Clerk presented the audited accounts for the year to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015 and the Council gave approval for these to be submitted to the external auditor.

**7 A.O.B.**

- The Clerk was asked if he had received a planning application for a wind turbine to be erected on land very close to the boundary between Llanfihangel Rhydithon and Bleddfa: the Clerk replied that no application had been received by him via Post Office mail or email.
