3 Minutes of meeting held on 24th August 2017:

4 Matters arising:

- No report has been received from County Cllr Fitzpatrick concerning the traffic problems in Dolau. There was further discussion regarding double white lines, speed measurement and flashing speed signs, but the inescapable fact is that, at present, the speed limit is 60mph.
- The Chairman reported that he has not received any communication from the Data Protection Department of Dyfed Powys Police Force, but will renew his efforts to obtain a reply to his request for a full record of all reported incidents on the A488 through Dolau.

• Cllr Kath Bufton reported that the Dolau Primary School roll is 35 children - down because of a change of age for receiving children into Reception and the departure of a three-children family from the community. The school's achievement levels continue to rise and it is heading for the green quartile this year. The school is above the Welsh average for

- standards in general. The up-to-date news is that Powys is recommending that the partnership with Llanelwedd School be formalised, which would ensure safety for the school from any threat of closure.
- Cllr David Lewis reported that he had not attended the most recent meeting of Dolau Recreation Association but he had received the Minutes of that meeting on his mobile phone. He gave a short resumé of those Minutes.
